



Hygiene Policy

1. Parents/carers should take children to the toilets to change nappies (the disabled toilet has a changing shelf). Changing nappies on the carpeted areas is not allowed.
2. All soiled nappies to be placed in the nappy bucket in the disabled toilet.
3. All helpers to wash hands before and after preparing drinks and food.
4. All work surfaces to be cleaned before and after use.
5. If a child is sick, the child should be comforted by the parent/carer and removed from the area. The leader and or helper should ensure the area is thoroughly cleaned and disinfected, wearing disposable gloves.
6. All parents and carers to be encouraged to bring in their own child's drinking cup. Cups used frequently often get chewed by young children and are difficult to keep clean.
