1 Lord, our Lord,

2 Through the praise of children and infants
you have established a stronghold against your enemies,

3 When I consider your heavens,
the work of your fingers,
the moon and the stars,
which you have set in place,

We see God's greatness everywhere we look - his fingerprints are in the skies, in newborn babes, all creation's marvels point to the Creator.

4 what is mankind that you are mindful of them,
human beings that you care for them?

The universe is infinitely big, incredibly complex - and yet he sees me!
Sees each action, each tear, each smile.
More than that, he cared so very much about us, he gave us his only Son.
v2 looks forward to the shouts of joy as Jesus enters Jerusalem

5 You have made them a little lower than the angels
and crowned them with glory and honour.

6 You made them rulers over the works of your hands;
you put everything under their feet:

7 all flocks and herds,
and the animals of the wild,

8 the birds in the sky,
and the fish in the sea,

all that swim the paths of the seas.

These verses too are applied to Jesus in Heb 2v6-8.
And He goes ahead to prepare a place for us, to be with him for ever.

9 Lord, our Lord,
how majestic is your name in all the earth!

Now he says v1 again, but with added depth: His majesty revealed in creation, in Jesus,
and in his plan of redemption!

Unto Jesus be all glory, honour and praise,
Majesty, kingdom authority
Flow from His throne, unto His own
His Anthem raise
Majesty, worship His majesty*
